**BOARD OF Trustees Meeting Minutes**

**April 13, 2026 7:00 pm**

Meeting was called to order by trustee Martin @ 7:10 on April 13, 2026.

Answering roll call: Trustees Ricky Blackman, Jeff Flanagan, Tony Woodward, Shelly Martin, Lisa Cookson. **Quorum declared.**

**Mayor's Report:**

Disney had a successful BMR event weekend. We had 35 food truck vendors and a huge number of people attended.

April 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> there will be the GOAT X rally which is a first for Disney. Also on April 25<sup>th</sup> is a fundraiser poker run for Maverick.

One of our long-time business owners and community supporter, Russ Hogan, has fallen very ill with Parkinson's disease and is currently on Hospice care.

**Department Reports:**

Hear Police Department report:

Review maintenance reports on police vehicles and equipment:

Storm siren repair \$1,100.00 for new circuit board. It was determined this can wait.

The 2020 black Explorer had all recalls fixed.

Trustee Flanagan asked when we acquired the 2023 white Explorer police car. Chief Sanders explained it was paid for by a Grand Gateway Grant.

The new cars will get new lettering as Larry is getting bids for pricing.

Police truck still needs repair.

- C. March 2026 Bank statements—Trustee Martin motioned to approve, Trustee Woodward seconded. Voting-Trustees Woodward-yes, Flanagan-yes, Cookson-yes, Martin-yes, Blackman-yes. Motion carried.
- D. March 2026 purchase orders—Trustee Martin motioned to approve, Trustee Blackman seconded. Voting- Trustees—Flanagan-yes, Woodward-yes, Cookson-yes, Martin-yes, Blackman-yes. Motion carried.
2. Discussion and possible action on recommendations from Planning and Zoning commission meeting. Trustee Woodward stated specific ordinances for the tiny homes and VRH will need a change of wording or removed entirely.
3. Discussion and possible action to adopt the recommendations from Planning and Zoning and to approve the VRH and tiny home ordinances. Trustee Martin explained that this is for residential zones and has been reviewed by our attorney. The mayor and city council have received complaints and concerns from citizens of Disney regarding both tiny homes and VRH. The proposed ordinances were reviewed and discussed. A vote to approve them has been tabled to next month’s city council meeting on May 11, 2026.
4. Discussion and possible action to close and block off Construction Drive for the GOAT X rally. Trustee Martin made a motion to approve, Trustee Flanagan seconded. Voting-Trustees-Flanagan-yes, Woodward-yes, Cookson-yes, Martin-yes, Blackman-yes. Motion carried.
5. Old Business. Citizen Amy Flanagan asked for confirmation that next election will be managed by Mayes County Election Board.
6. Unforeseen Business.
7. Hear, consider, and possible action from petitions from audience. Citizen Sharon Morey read her concerns to the council regarding VRH ordinances and asked they vote no. Citizen Jason McMurray asked when he would get a reply to his email requests from our attorney. Trustee Martin explained the attorney is working on those and will respond.
8. Comments from board members and town clerk.
9. Approval of Adjournment. Trustee Martin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Woodward 2<sup>nd</sup>. Voting-Trustees Blackman, Flanagan, Cookson, Martin-yes, and Woodward voted yes. MC. Adjournment at 10:09 p.m.
